





## A letter to all Brethren churches from David Radcliff

Brother David Radcliff is no stranger to many of us who have been to National Youth events and Annual Conference. He is currently the director of New Community Project, a para-church ministry that promotes peace through justice, care for creation, and experiential learning. Based in Blue Ridge, VA, David travels widely throughout the U.S. as a speaker and educator. He has written the following letter to Church of the Brethren congregations.

Dear friends in Christ, as I write, another hurricane is bearing down on the southeastern coast. This in itself is not unusual for this time of year, but the intensity of these storms is. For instance, scientists are telling us that storms like this can bring [50% more precipitation](#) than in a pre-climate changed world. So while our churches are great in responding with rebuilding teams and other emergency relief, what really needs to happen to save lives and homes is to turn down the heat on the planet.

Our creator promised to never again destroy the earth by flooding--now it seems like we might. (I often wonder if God has some lament about putting us in charge of caring for this amazing creation.)

In terms of climate change, it's only going to get worse for everything and everyone: I'm sure you heard about the latest IPCC report telling us that we need to act sooner and more drastically than previously thought to prevent more suffering for God's people and more ravages of God's creation. Here's a summary section from [this](#) article highlighting the danger of allowing our world to warm by 3.6 degrees (the previously set "upper limit" of allowable warming) as opposed to 2.7 degrees:

*It turns out there are [enormous differences](#) for the planet in that 0.5°C between the two scenarios: Marine fisheries would face double the declines with 2°C (3.6 F) of warming compared to 1.5°C (2.7 F). Maize harvests would decrease by more than double. Insects, including vital pollinators, would see their ranges decline threefold. Sea levels would rise by another 2 inches, putting an extra 10 million people at risk of coastal flooding and related problems. The number of people exposed to extreme heat at least once every five years doubles under a 2°C scenario relative to a 1.5°C scenario. (The [World Resources Institute](#) has a great infographic comparing the two scenarios.)*

*In other words, things will get bad as the climate warms, but if it gets hotter, those effects will get worse. "Climate-related risks to health, livelihoods, food security, water supply, human security, and economic growth are projected to increase with global warming of 1.5°C and increase further with 2°C," according to the report.*

Often an issue like this, along with creation care in general, isn't a regular part of our conversations in congregational settings. As we see, however, this is more than an "environmental" issue--human well-being is clearly at stake. And there's the little matter of justice--while the poor in the world will suffer first and worst from this gathering storm, it is not they but we who are principally responsible, thanks to our high rates of emissions now and in the past.

As such, the challenge of climate change presents an opportunity for the church to provide leadership by doing what it is so well-placed to do--calling for justice, promoting simplicity, and honoring God as Creator.

Please see us at NCP as a resource as you seek to engage your congregation with this "new world (dis)order."

Courage and strength for the journey--blessings on your ministries and witness within and beyond the congregation.
