Its mission is to help feed the millions upon millions of hungry people throughout the world. **However, because of COVID, there was NO Chambersburg community CROP Walk again this year.** Instead, we will be collecting donations to help CROP in their time-tested efforts

to feed the hungry. Please be an advocate of CROP because it is so vital in the fight against hunger. Donations can be made by making checks payable to Chambersburg COB and dropping it in the offering plate or payable to CWS/CROP and dropping it by the church office.

The 2021 Congregational Council Meeting will be held on Sunday, November 21 at 11 am in the Sanctuary following the combined worship service at 10 am. Please bring a pen or pencil to mark your ballots as they will not be distributed at the meeting. Council packets for the meeting are in your church boxes TODAY. Given the unusual circumstances associated with COVID, church members who do not feel comfortable attending the meeting in person will be given the opportunity to vote for new Board members, confirm annual conference and district conference delegates and vote on the 2022 budget by absentee ballot. On Thursday, November 18, Carol Wingert and a Board member will be at the church from 5-7 pm to distribute and collect ballots. To vote, you will drive into the parking lot behind the church and remain in your car. You will be handed two ballots per member. After marking the ballots, you will place them into separate, closed boxes, which will not be opened until Sunday morning when the other ballots are counted. Please note that allowing voting by absentee ballot again this year does not establish a precedent for absentee ballots at future council meetings. We are simply responding to limitations presented in relation to COVID concerns and in the spirit of including members who cannot risk exposure.
